

Our hearts and thoughts go out to all who are affected by this unprecedented event. The top priority for HAIP is the safety of its members, families and our community. The Governor issued a statewide Stay-At-Home Work Order effective March 25, 2020 through April 30, 2020. As of

April 21st, Honolulu Mayor Kirk Caldwell extended the city's Stay-At-Home order through May 31, 2020. Business and personal travel was discouraged. Social distancing became an everyday practice requiring all persons to maintain a minimum of six feet of physical separation from all other persons.

These mandates impacted HAIP's events (luncheons, CE classes and Community Relations projects). With the recent update from Mayor Caldwell, HAIP's March, April, and May events are cancelled or postponed. We are looking at alternative options to collaborate and connect with members locally. HAIP will keep everyone advised once we finalize options.
